**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420(c)(9)**

THIS MATTER is before the Court on a Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records filed by PLAINTIFF, TAYLAN CENK ISKENDER, pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) for an order determining the confidentiality of the following information relative to this case: **VERIFIED COMPLAINT and all exhibits thereto.**

There are no affected non-parties to the Motion.

This motion was not contested and a hearing was not conducted.

Having considered the arguments of the parties, legal authority, and otherwise being fully advised, the Court **GRANTS** the motion as follows:

1. Confidentiality of the information is required in accordance with Rule of Judicial Administration to protect the following interest:
 - f. Avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in this type of proceeding, specifically: Forcing the otherwise non-breaching party to breach the settlement agreement by publishing its terms.
 - g. Complying with established public policy set forth in the Florida or U.S. Constitution or statutes or Florida rules or case law, specifically: Honoring contract terms.

2. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect these interests, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interest(s).

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

The Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to treat as confidential immediately the following materials related to this matter and to keep such materials from public access: The VERIFIED COMPLAINT and all exhibits thereto. However, the file and progress docket shall otherwise remain available to the public subject to any substitution of a party's name set forth above.

It is further **ORDERED** that any materials determined to be confidential pursuant to this Order may be disclosed only as follows:

1. To any judge of this Circuit for case-related reasons;
2. To the Chief Judge or his or her designee;
3. To an authorized governmental agency;
4. To the following specific individuals: NONE; or
5. By further Order of the Court.

It is further **ORDERED** that, within 10 days of the date of this Order, the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the bulletin board of the Seventh Judicial Circuit and on the Clerk's website for a period of 30 days to provide public notice.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to open any materials determined to be confidential pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be treated as confidential immediately upon completion of the filing.
