**AGREED ORDER ON MOTION TO DETERMINE THE CONFIDENTIALITY  
OF COURT RECORDS**

**THIS CAUSE** having come before the Court on the Motion to Determine the Confidentiality of Court Records filed by Plaintiffs, Michael Prelec, Jr., Chase Clarke, and Carson Clarke (“Plaintiffs”) on April 13, 2026, Filing #245880880, and the Court having reviewed the Motion, being advised that Defendants have agreed to the entry of this Order, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

**ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Exhibits A-C attached to the Declaration of C. Brett Cooper filed April 13, 2026, Filing #245880880, are deemed confidential, for purposes of the Court record, during the pendency of this civil case. This determination is made pursuant to the Court’s March 24, 2025 Agreed Confidentiality Order, as amended, and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9)(A)( i), (ii), (iv), and (vi). As such, the exhibits shall not be available on the public docket, and shall be sealed in accordance with Florida Rules of General Practice and

Judicial Administration 2.420(e)(3). The parties to this case shall be permitted to view the exhibits during the pendency of this case.

3. The Clerk is hereby directed to seal Exhibits A-C of the Declaration of C. Brett Cooper filed on April 13, 2026, Filing #245880880 in the public record.

4. This Order does not affect the discoverability of the Exhibits or the ability for them to be used in this case so long as the Exhibits remain and are treated as confidential for purposes of the Court file. To the extent any party seeks to use the Exhibits publicly at the time of trial, the Court will address such requests at that time.

5. The Court finds that (i) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c) of Rule 2.42, and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c) of Rule 2.420. The Clerk of the Court is directed to publish this Order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4).

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(5) of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration.
