ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS

have not been determined to be confidential.

- D. The court record containing the confidential information is as follows:

 - ii. Date of filing: March 26, 2025;
 - iii. Date of document: March 26, 2025;
 - iv. Docket entry number: 132;
 - v. The confidential information within the document is precisely located at: minimum sale prices listed in Paragraph 7 of the Petition, which are trade secrets.

2. Persons permitted to view this confidential information are limited to beneficiaries and bona fide creditors of the Estate or of the decedent.

3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to redact the minimum sale prices listed in Paragraph 7 of the Petition.

4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to publish this Order in accordance with Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(e)(4).

5. The Personal Representative shall file a notice within ten (10) days of the sale of each property listed in Paragraph 7 of the Petition, and at such time, the minimum sale price in Paragraph 7 of the Petition related to that property will no longer be confidential, and the Clerk of the Court shall remove the redaction from it.
