**ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS MATTER coming before the court on the petition of the duly appointed Curator, Heather Bond Vargas, the Court, having reviewed the petition and being otherwise fully advised in the premises it is:

ADJUDGED that the Petition is GRANTED. It is further

ADJUDGED that the cause of death and information contained in the medical records and affidavit surrounding the circumstances of the cause of death is information that is determined confidential under Fla. Stat. 382.008(6), Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(i) and (v). No other case information, including the names of the parties or progress docket, are deemed confidential. The information determined to be confidential is attached hereto as Exhibit A in its redacted form. It is further

ADJUDGED that Fla. Stat. 382.008(6) necessitates that the cause of death is exempt from the provisions of Florida Statute 119.07(1) allowing public inspection of records. It is further

ADJUDGED that pursuant to Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(i), the information contained in the Petition and Affidavit should remain confidential to prevent a serious and imminent threat to the fair, impartial, and orderly administration of justice. It is further

ADJUDGED that Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(v) requires the information remain confidential to avoid substantial injury to the Decedent's minor children. It is further

ADJUDGED that the only individuals permitted to view the cause of death and confidential medical records, absent further order of this Court, are the nominated personal representative and her attorneys. It is further

ADJUDGED that the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality declared in this Order are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9). No less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9); and

ADJUDGED that the clerk of the court is directed to publish the order in accordance with Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. (e)(5).
